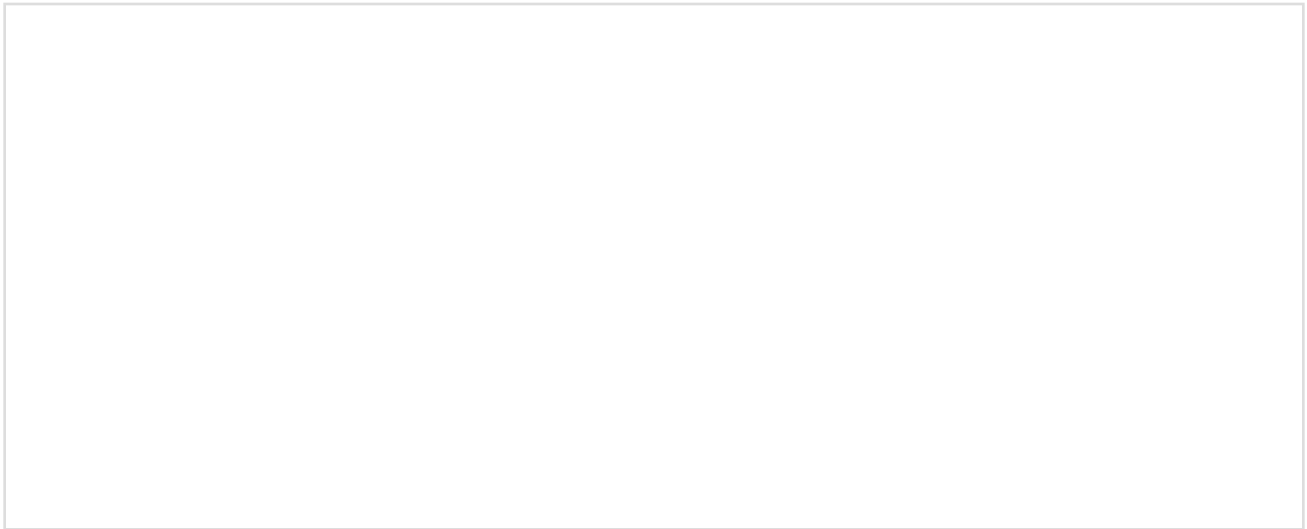

Scammers have been exploiting people's fears in the wake of recent attacks in Europe by posting fake news of a 'terrorist act' in Prague, in an attempt to gain access to internet users' personal data.
